This book is a UUA report from the Commission on Institutional Change and may help us all in our current process of reimagining our future together. Please see the article in the newsletter from the Board for information about registering.

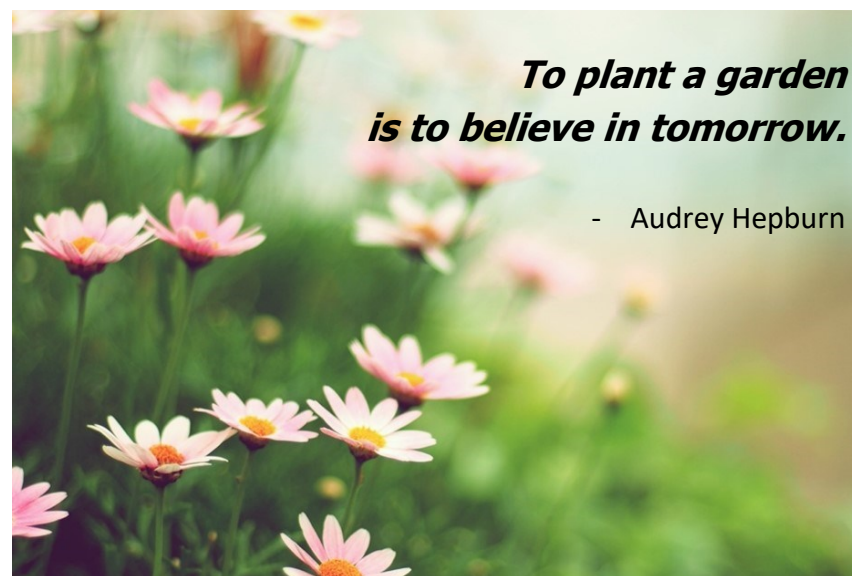
