

**Gun Violence Prevention Generosity Sunday

Paving Great Futures (PGF), is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization committed to empowering at-risk communities throughout the five districts of San Diego County. Paving Great Futures (PGF) was founded in 2012 by Barry Harris Jr., Armand King, and Jay Bowser, three San Diego natives who grew up in impoverished and gang-afflicted areas of the city. PGF serves clients aged 12-30 at high risk of gang-related activity, substance abuse/distribution, incarceration, homelessness, sex trafficking, and violence.

One of PGF's outreach programs, TWEEN SWAG engages high school students, community members and justice involved individuals on the impact of gun violence and community-led efforts to reduce violence. Their trauma-informed services recognize and respond to the impact of trauma, emphasizing physical, psychological and emotional safety, while promoting empowerment and healing.

The Sunday collection for June 26th will go to PGF.

As we head into summer, there will be days when the electrical power grid will have trouble keeping up with demand. During power use surges, fast acting (and dirty and expensive) power plants are brought online to meet demand. A company called OhmConnect.com serves as a virtual power station working with SDG&E and users to reduce use during these key times so there is enough electricity to go around, without (resorting to those polluting power plants).

If you sign up in the next few days (before the end of June), UUFSD will get a referral fee, \$40, and each participant will get \$10, so it's a win-win all the way around.
