UUFSD Article II Task Force Kickoff Presentation Sunday, October 1, 2023, 11:30am – 12:30pm, Founders' Hall

The proposal to revise Article II of the UUA bylaws squarely raises the question, "What Does It Mean to be a UU?" The 7 Principles and 6 Sources of UUism, which have centered us as UUs since 1985, are eliminated as separate concepts and replaced by 6 proposed UU "values"—"Interdependence," "Equity," "Transformation," "Generosity," "Pluralism" and "Justice," all based on "Love." The new proposal will be adopted or rejected by vote at the UU General Assembly next June.

Our Board has established a Task Force to engage the entire congregation over the coming months in learning, discussion, and debate about the revision. On October 1, the Task Force will lead an all-congregation meeting after service for education and clarification about the proposal. This will kick off other, more informal opportunities for discussion throughout the year.
